- ✓ Give background, natural history, and other facts about the stories and writing the stories.

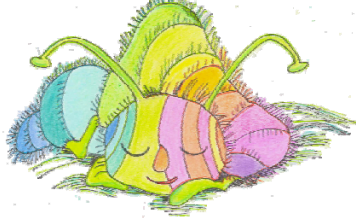
